

Gifted Identification

In accordance with Ohio Revised Code (3324.01-.07) and Ohio Administrative Code (3301-51-15), Sylvania Schools will accept referrals for gifted identification from parents/guardians, teachers, students and community members for students who may, “perform or show potential for performing at remarkably high levels of accomplishment when compared to others of their age, experience or environment.”

Sylvania Schools will identify children of the district in grades K-12, based on identification criteria as established by the State of Ohio and in one or more of the following categories: superior cognitive ability, specific academic ability, creative thinking ability and visual or performing arts.

The district will provide two testing opportunities each year. Referrals received between April 1 - September 30 will fall into the first test window. Referrals received between October 1 - March 31 will fall into the second test window. During 2011-2012, as we transition to the new testing schedule, the first referral period will be extended through October 31, 2011.
